PICK UP AND RETURN INFORMATION



All tours shown in this catalog will pick up in **Staunton**, **Charlottesville** and **Richmond** unless otherwise noted. Additional pick up and return points are also available when a tour travels through certain towns. For example, if a tour is heading north on **Interstate 95** we would be able to pick up and return to Fredericksburg. If you feel that this is a possibility on the tour that you have chosen, please call our Office for that information. If you wish to change the pick up point that you have previously chosen please contact us at **1-800-552-0022**.

We ask that you arrive at your pick up point at least **15 minutes prior** to the time listed in your letter. The time listed in the **LETTER** is when the bus should pull out. The pick up and return times in the **CATALOG** are approximate depending on the number of passengers traveling and situations such as traffic, weather, or other delays.

SUNSHINE TOURS GROUP TRAVEL

<u>Seat Rotation</u> - Sunshine Tours uses a seat rotation system for all passengers to enjoy different views from the bus as well as to meet everyone traveling on the tour. The Tour Director will help facilitate this rotation by asking the group to move two seats each day on a tour five to ten days in length and one seat each day on a tour longer than ten days.

Luggage - Sunshine Tours allows one bag per person that will be delivered to the room on arrival (where indicated) and one carry on piece. Remember if you can't lift it easily, think about your driver and bell staff. Your one large, sturdy bag, (no large duffle bags) should be maximum 10" deep, 14" high and 24"long. The compartments over the seats must be shared with fellow passengers therefore please limit the size to one SMALL "Flexible" carry on bag per person. Small, hard-side luggage does not fit. Pack Light as our tours are very casual!

Itinerary - Sometimes it is necessary to alter the itinerary or arrangements and Sunshine Tours reserves the right to do so without penalty. Time constraints, mechanical failure, weather or unavailability of an event are all conditions for change.

Refunds - Please refer to the terms and conditions in the back of the Catalog for our refund policy.

in AD 500-750. After we leave Mesa Verde we visit the **Four Corner's Monument** which is the only place in the country where four states meet. A REAL ID-compliant license is one that meets and is issued by a state that complies with the REAL ID Act's security standards. A REAL ID (an enhanced license) can be obtained at your local DMV.
